

The largest bronze work we cast was two 2/3rd life-sized skiers for a Colorado monument of my design. I also cast for 6 or 8 other Artists including my friend Felix de Weldon, the sculptor who created the famous Marine Corps Monument (Iwo Jima) in Washington DC.

I conducted several Master Classes at my Studio On-the-Ridge guiding experienced artists through the process of creating major sculptures, conducted classes for special needs students with the State and held weekly group and private art classes.

In 1995 and 2000 I won two NH % Percent for Art competitions creating a total of 4 Major Copper Repousse Weather-vanes which stand today, placed on state buildings as the largest vanes created in New Hampshire and possibly New England.

With the creation of the new Art n Gun Foundry and Forge I hope to expand with my friend Joe Filipowski who is also a teacher, craftsman and deeply dedicated to the maritime a unique Atelier. A place and atmosphere open to creativity and new processes in bronze casting and metal fabrication.
